Organizational principles:

1. The pre-state exam practical training in internal medicine aims at improving students' theoretical knowledge and providing them with practical skills from individual subspecialties of internal medicine.
2. Students' 6 hours daily (i.e. 7:00 – 13:00) must fully be completed to get certification.
3. The entire pre-state examination practical training takes 10 weeks (weeks 9 and 10 are reserved for consultations)
4. The incapacity for work must be certified. Up to 5 days may be tolerated under condition of due compensation after agreement with the teacher in charge.

5. The training comprises activities similar to those performed by pre-registration house officers, in particular bedside care supervised by experienced doctors.
6. Students should learn and even practice all medical procedures to be performed with their patients, invasive and non-invasive methods incl.
7. Credit will be signed against completed attendance sheet (Annex) by teacher in charge of practical training on Dept of Internal Medicine I, II or III.
8. Current examination questions will serve for actual state exams. The multiple choice test remains valid for this academic year, both in Czech and English programmes.
9. State exams terms: 13th Feb – 17th Feb 2012
