Mr. Goncharov will be a co-author of this article. The third part of scientific work performed by Mr. Goncharov will include tissue biomarker evaluation of slides stained by immunohistochemistry with further data analysis and interpretation. These results will be presented at the students scientific conference this year.

During the whole period of our collaboration Mr. Goncharov showed his strong theoretical background in medicine, pathology, molecular pathology and especially in oncopathology, the thoroughness at acquiring data of the highest quality and also his attention to detail.
